Sacrament of Confirmation: Timetable & Eligibility 2024

1. Rite of Welcome Mass (was Sept 10th):

- This is the first public ritual for confirmation candidates.
- Expresses the intention to follow the way of Jesus Christ and asks for the support of our community to pray.

2. Confirmation Candidate Registration:

- Complete Registration Form and provide a copy of Baptismal Certificate.
- Maintain reliable, permanent, and accurate records.
- Do this as soon as possible.

3. Choosing a Sponsor:

- Sponsors must meet specific qualifications.
- A parent can stand in, but only if there is no other suitable sponsor.

4. Choosing a Confirmation Name:

• Candidates may use their baptismal name or a Christian name.

5. Knowledge Requirements:

- Know the 10 Commandments
- Know the <u>7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit.</u>
- Be prepared to list how you were of service to your parish.

6. Confirmation Interview: IMPORTANT Dec 26th-Jan 21 St time slots only!

- <u>Scheduled date (Note Location)</u> **Do this soon!**
- Candidates and parents attend together.
- An alternative family member can attend if a parent cannot.

7. Parents/Love Letter (Due by Feb):

- Write a love letter to your son or daughter.
- Seal and submit directly to Maureen or the parish office.
- Kept a secret until the retreat.

8. Bishop Letter of Intent/Questionnaire (Due by Feb):

- The Archbishop requests that candidates use the questionnaire form instead of a letter.
- Questionnaires should be printed and signed by candidates, then read by the director prior to submission to the Archdioceses. Please return by Feb 2024!

9. Confirmation Retreat (March 9-10) Overnight:

- Archdiocesan requirement.
- PERMISSION SLIP
- Explore alternatives if unable to attend the scheduled retreat.

10. Confirmation Rehearsal & Sponsor Night (April 2nd, 6-8 pm):

- Essential for preparation.
- Provides an opportunity for sponsors and candidates to share faith.
- Parents can attend if sponsors are unavailable.

11. Class Attendance Requirements:

- Attend all classes and Masses regularly.
- An attendance record is maintained and made available at interview.

12. Service Hours:

- Community service is critical for preparation and is made available at interviews.
- 10 service hours are required. <u>Download service hours document.</u>

13. Confirmation Day (April 7th, 2 pm at St. Clare):

- Arrive 15-30 minutes early.
- 14. **If you can not attend the April 7th Confirmation** at St. Clare, let Maureen know. She will help you locate another date at another parish. <u>Parishes and Confirmation dates.</u>

Confirmation is not a graduation, but a step in ongoing faith formation. Adult formation opportunities are available for all participants. Your active involvement enriches the Church's mission.
