- We will offer opportunities to take a half-day mission trip to Milwaukee's homeless shelters to work and distribute food and clothing. Dates will be posted.

- Help at a fish fry and any other church events throughout the year. Dates will be posted.

Q: Does it count if I do service hours outside of church sponsored events?

A: We are excited you are volunteering your time and talent within our community and hope you continue! **However, all Faith Formation Service Hours must be earned through St. Clare or St. Thomas sponsored events.**

Anything you do outside St. Thomas or St. Clare can count towards service projects and should be mentioned in your interview with the priest/deacon and in your letter to the bishop as a Junior. With every hour earned, you are one step closer to shifting your focus from serving yourself to serving others. This is a guaranteed way to build happiness in your life!
