Apostles Creed

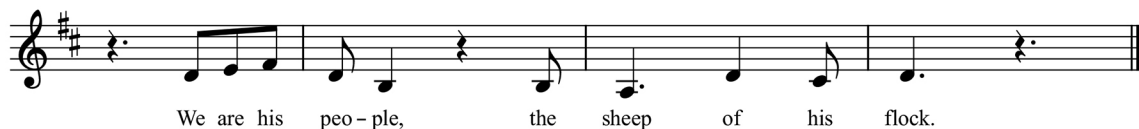
